Call for Nominations:

Nominations are called for the position of President of the AHF as well as for the positions of Directors of the AHF (1 term of 2 years and 1 term of 1 year) due for election in 2010. Please note that Paul Smith as President and two directors are incumbent and are eligible for re-election, should they choose to stand.

Notice of AGM

In accordance with the AHF Constitution (clause 30), notice is hereby given of the Annual General Meeting of the AHF, to be held in Sydney on Saturday, 17 April 2010.

In accordance with the AHF Constitution (clause 20 and 30), all nominations for the position of President (term of 2 years) and Directors of the AHF (1 term of 2 years and 1 term of 1 year) as well as any additional Agenda items for the AGM must be submitted to the Secretary-General by 20 March 2010, in order to allow for the Agenda and details of all nominations to be distributed prior to the AGM.

Furthermore, can all State Associations please nominate or confirm their State Directors, appointed to the AHF Board and eligible to vote at the AHF AGM also by 20 March 2010.

All nomination must be:

- 1 in writing;
- 2 on the prescribed form provided for that purpose (see attached);
- 3 signed by a nominator and a seconder, who shall be Individual Members; and
- 4 certified by the nominee expressing his willingness to accept the position for which he or she is nominated.
